

says Jim Rise, Business Development Manager, Grundfos. "Considering that the majority of errors in pits are caused by float switches or electrodes that fail, taking these away removes what has been a weak link and brings substantial cost benefits."

Eliminate complexity and reduce service calls and costs

AUTOADAPT ensures the wastewater pump systems operate reliably, reducing commissioning and installation costs by up to 50% while maintaining surveillance and necessary alarms. Internal monitoring is installed as



standard, ensuring the pump never runs dry. Removing the at-risk areas from pump installations means a reduction in the need for service calls by 75%.

AUTOADAPT eliminates complexity. AUTOADAPT pumps will adapt automatically when placed in the pit and can detect the presence of other pumps. Up to four pumps will automatically calibrate their start/stop levels and fall into a pump alternation routine, ensuring optimum performance at all times. Furthermore, the pumps will adapt to periods with high in-flow by running parallel operation.
